

## Stitch map for Growth Chart narrow

The first thing that stitches is the outside lines (green) that also stitch the inch markings.

On a Statler, the machine will pause. This is to let you know it is time to stitch the numbers. You could put fabric down and do raw edge applique for the numbers or just stitch the quilted outline.

After #6, on the Statler, the machine will pause. Here you will lay down your backing fabric, right side down, and the machine will stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " inside the outside edge (red lines). This will allow you to envelope turn, stitch the turning hole closed and will not have to bind it. If you want to do binding, stop after quilting the #6.
